Department Overview

Medical Affairs colleagues are key to conveying the science behind company products to the healthcare community and work closely with various cross-functional teams within the company that are involved in various stages of a product's life-cycle. The medical affairs team apply insights learned to help improve the patient journey, leading to more efficient management of their condition by healthcare professionals

The UK Medical Affairs Teams consist of doctors, pharmacists and colleagues with life sciences backgrounds, who work closely with cross-functional teams (colleagues from other departments) to deliver on projects and activities and provide medical and scientific expertise across various therapy areas. The Medical Affairs teams are also involved in developing new approaches to engage with and partner with healthcare professionals, patients and other healthcare stakeholders.

The purpose of the undergraduate role is to gain an insight into the pharmaceutical industry and meet experts working in a wide range of roles and departments. The opportunities to work cross-functionally with other teams, offers an insight into the different career opportunities the pharmaceutical industry has to offer.

What can I achieve and what will I be accountable for whilst completing a placement at Pfizer?



As part of a vibrant and talented medical affairs team, you can look forward to developing numerous skills and being a valued team player.

You will develop a multitude of skills including:

- · Communication and interactive skills through liaising with colleagues and external stakeholders
- Organisational and project management skills through working on a variety of projects
- Presentation skills by discussing your work at meetings, as well as the opportunity to chair some meetings
- Teamwork skills through your role in various matrix teams
- Developing the initiative to think proactively with the responsibility of managing your own projects

It is also a fantastic way to obtain a better comprehension of the pharmaceutical industry and the types of roles it has to offer.

Roles and opportunities will include:

- Project Management: Assist the Medical Affairs team with key projects and deliverables
 aligned with the medical strategy. This will include supporting and delivering projects for
 both internal and external stakeholders. For instance, this may include projects relating to
 data analysis and presentation, investigator-initiated research (ISR), clinical trials, noninterventional studies, database studies and registries.
- **Research Skills:** Help the Medical Affairs team to stay abreast of relevant published literature and developments, by reviewing and summarising key information
- **Scientific Expertise:** You will develop in-depth scientific knowledge of dermatology, and across the Pfizer dermatology portfolio (including pipeline assets)
- Compliance: Training will be provided on the Association of British Pharmaceutical Industry (ABPI) Code of practice and Pfizer standard operating procedures (SOPs). You will compile relevant case studies and keep up to date with relevant industry regulations, to maintain the team's knowledge
- Training: Supporting educational teams with the training of field colleagues on scientific medical data
- Culture & Organisational Leadership: Multiple opportunities exist for undergraduates
 to get involved in Pfizer cultural enhancing projects, such as Volunteering Days, STEM
 outreach and engagement, Sustainability programs and Diversity & Inclusion initiatives



Pfizer offers a supportive environment which allows employees numerous opportunities to grow and develop. This is a great chance to be part of the bigger picture, and to assist in ensuring Pfizer maintains a strong and diverse workforce as well as developing a talent pipeline of future Pfizer colleagues. There may be opportunities to work with people from other departments including fellow undergraduate trainees. You may also get opportunities to attend conferences, meetings and training in relation to the projects that you work on.
